Judges followed the National PTA Rubric, requiring Interpretation of Theme to factor as half the total score, based on the artwork itself and artist statement. Artistic Merit/Creativity and Mastery of Medium make up the other half.

First place entries advanced to the City of Alexandria competition. The sculpture category, unique to MVCS, does not advance to the City.

Artistic Merit Awards are selected by Reflections Chairs to honor entries deserving of noteworthy recognition.

Winners will be recognized at a ceremony on February 20, 2015.
